



Taking Care of God's Creation

This past weekend Pastor Ken continued the series Masterclass. We are looking at one of life's biggest questions – what is our purpose in life? During this series we would like to invite you to go through these points with someone at work, your family, or find a place to do it alone or with a friend. Let's grow and do life together.

The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, the world, and those who dwell in it.

Psalm 24:1 NASB

1. This week we looked at what the Bible has to say about creation and the role we play in taking care of it (read Genesis 1:1-2:9 and Psalm 95:4-5).
2. The first thing to notice is that God is the creator and ruler over all, and we are created to rule (or manage) under Him. He made us in His image and put us in the world to represent or to manage things for Him.
3. The first way that we can put this into practice is to take care of creation while we manage our part of the garden or where we live. Think of a few ways that you can do that and purpose in your heart to do something this week to make it a better place. It could have something to do with recycling, using solar, planting trees, adjusting our thermostat or sprinklers or a host of other ideas.
4. The second way that Pastor Ken shared with us to take care of creation is to treat animals with the dignity that is due them (read Proverbs 12:10). How could God use you this week to work for the humane treatment of animals? Maybe you could give financially to a group working to do this or volunteer at a local animal shelter. It could also be by providing a home for a rescue pet.
