Created to Become Like Christ

This past weekend Pastor Ken continued the series *Masterclass*. We are looking at one of life's biggest questions – what is our purpose in life? During this series we would like to invite you to go through these points with someone at work, your family, or find a place to do it alone or with a friend. Let's grow and do life together.

God wants us to grow up ... like Christ in everything. Ephesians 4:15 Msg

1. After we give our life to Christ, God's greatest desire is that we become like Christ (Ephesians 5:1). Growth is a daily process, a little bit at a time. Let's take a look at how that can happen.
2. Learn to trust like Jesus as you face the pressures of life (read James 1:2-12). Instead of running away from pressure, take it to God and put your trust in Him. What problem in your life has caused the greatest growth in you?
3. Learn to overcome like Jesus when facing the temptations of life (read Matthew 4:1-11 and James 4:7). When you resist with the help of God you build moral muscle. When the enemy attacked, Jesus fought with the Word of God. What is one area where you need to stop thinking your way and start thinking God's way? Who could you ask to be a spiritual partner to help you defeat a persistent temptation by praying for you?
4. Learn to serve like Jesus when you face the relationships of life (read Matthew 16:24-26, 20:28 and Philippians 2:3). Instead of a life that is all about yourself learn to live beyond yourself. Think about the needs and interests of others and how you can serve them. Start your day by thinking about how you can love others. Who can you serve this week?
5. In what area of your life do you need to ask for the Spirit's power to be more like Christ today?
