What's Love Got to Do with It - Everything

This past weekend Pastor Ken started our new series called *Love Language*. We will be looking at love and how it is the most important word in the Bible. During this series we would like to invite you to go through these points with someone at work, your family, or find a place to do it alone or with a friend. Let's grow and do life together.

And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.
1 Corinthians 13:13 NIV

1. Begin by reading 1 Corinthians 13:1-8.
2. The most important word about love is found in the Bible. God is the source of love (read 1 John 4:7-8) and he created human beings to reflect his nature and character. This is what separates Christianity from all the religions of the world. The Holy Spirit can increase our capacity for and ability to love. So, if you want to increase the force of love move closer to the source of love, God Himself.
3. Our founding pastor, Kenny Foreman, achieved much for the Kingdom of God, but he never lost sight of the most important thing. He lived a life that was full of love. At the end of the day that is what matters most (read 1 Corinthians 14:1).
4. Love is more than a feeling that you have, love is a decision that you make (read John 13:34-35). Jesus is telling us to behave, speak, and think in loving ways, whether we have feelings of love or not. Can you see yourself by the power of the Holy Spirit growing in your capacity to love? Is there someone in your life that God can love through you? Think of some ways to show others the love of God this week.
